## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### 1) Venue

Kortrijk Xpo  
Doorniksesteenweg 216  
8500 Kortrijk  
BELGIUM

- Hall 4: BMX track
- Hall 5 (via P3): Riders Paddock, Entrance Riders & Public

- Saturday 21/01: EC BMX ROUND 7 *Cat. 4*
- Sunday 22/01: EC BMX ROUND 8 *Cat. 5*

### 3) Registration

Prices: Per Round:  
- 27 € Challenge  
- 35 € Junior  
- 57 € Elite

Late registration are possible after this date but with a penalty of double fee.

Pick up documents: Teammanagers:  
Friday 20/01/2012: 16:00-20:00 Hrs  
Location: Entrance IN/OUT XPO ZUID (see plan)

Riders:  
Location: Hall 5 (via P 3)

Documents: Each rider gets an envelope with 2 numbered bracelets in:  
1 for the rider and 1 for the bike. With these bracelets the rider has access to the Paddock (Hall 5) and the Track. Bikes are not allowed in Hall 4 outside the track and other Halls.

### 4) Visitors entry fee

Visitors can buy entrance tickets for 1 day or for the weekend.

- Dayticket (Saturday or Sunday): 11 € for adults and 6 € for children < 12 years
- Weekend ticket: 22 € for adults and 12 € for children < 12 years

With a day or weekend ticket you can also get access on Friday. No access on Friday without any ticket. With a ticket you have access to the Paddock, the Track and Velofollies.

Tickets can be bought

- online: [www.velofollies.be/bmxtickets](http://www.velofollies.be/bmxtickets) You'll receive a voucher with barcode that you can exchange for a ticket at the entrance of Hall 5 (via P3). This is only for weekend tickets. Day tickets have to be bought at the entrance.
- in Hall 5 (via P3).

## 5) Exhibition space for National & Registered Teams

Only national & registered teams can hire a location of 6m x 3m in Hall 5 to place their tent. Enclosed you'll find a floorplan with the possible locations. The teams who are interested have to send their application to [velofollies@kortrijkxpo.com](mailto:velofollies@kortrijkxpo.com).

1 location of 6m x 3m costs 100 € and has to be paid before placing the tent: a responsible of the teams has to present himself at the entrance IN/OUT ZUID (see enclosed plan). There he or she will receive clearance to enter Hall 5 with the tent and a vehicle for unloading all materials. No vehicles can stay in the hall during the weekend.

## 6) commercial space

It is possible to hire a commercial space to sell products (no catering can be sold). These spaces have a minimum of 16 m<sup>2</sup> (4m x 4m) and a maximum of 48 m<sup>2</sup> (4m x 12m) and can be hired for 20 €/m<sup>2</sup>. ## 7) Camping facilities for motorhomes and caravans

- As for the previous editions of the national championships in Kortrijk, there is an area available opposite the Kortrijk Xpo campus (see plan): Car Park no.1 P+R, Kennedylaan, 8500 Kortrijk. This car park will be reserved for caravans and motorhomes, and arranged to welcome them (asphalt underground). This Car Park will be open from Friday 20 January at 14:00 hrs until Sunday 22 January at 20:00 hrs, and is on walking distance to the track. There is no electricity supply. Costs or the cost of a parking ticket, 4 €/day.

## 11) How to get here (see attached plan)

### By car:

Kortrijk Xpo is situated next to exit 2 (Kortrijk Zuid) of motorway E17 Antwerp - Gent

- From Brussels:  
E40 motorway to Ghent - E17 to Kortrijk - Exit 2 Hoog Kortrijk/Expo (90 km)
- From Antwerp:  
E17 motorway to Kortrijk - Exit 2 Hoog Kortrijk / Expo (98 km)
- From Mons-Doornik:  
E403 – E17 motorway (direction Ghent) - Exit Hoog Kortrijk / Expo (30 km)
- From Ostend-Bruges:  
E403 to Kortrijk - R8 (direction Kortrijk Zuid) - Exit 't Hoge - Exit 2 Hoog Kortrijk / Expo (Ostend: 65 km - Bruges: 50 km)
- From the Netherlands:  
A1 motorway to Breda - E17 Antwerp - Ghent - Kortrijk - Exit 2 Hoog Kortrijk / Expo (Breda: 155 km)

### By plane:

- From Wevelgem (Belgium):  
Business flights to and from Wevelgem airport make Kortrijk Xpo easily accessible by air. In Wevelgem a taxi will take you to our exhibition center within 5 minutes (7 km).
- From Brussels National Airport (Belgium):  
From Brussels International Airport, take a train to Brussels North and then a train to Kortrijk (100 km).
- From Lille/Lesquin (France):  
From Lille / Lesquin airport, take a taxi to Lille Flandres station and then the train to Kortrijk (40 km).

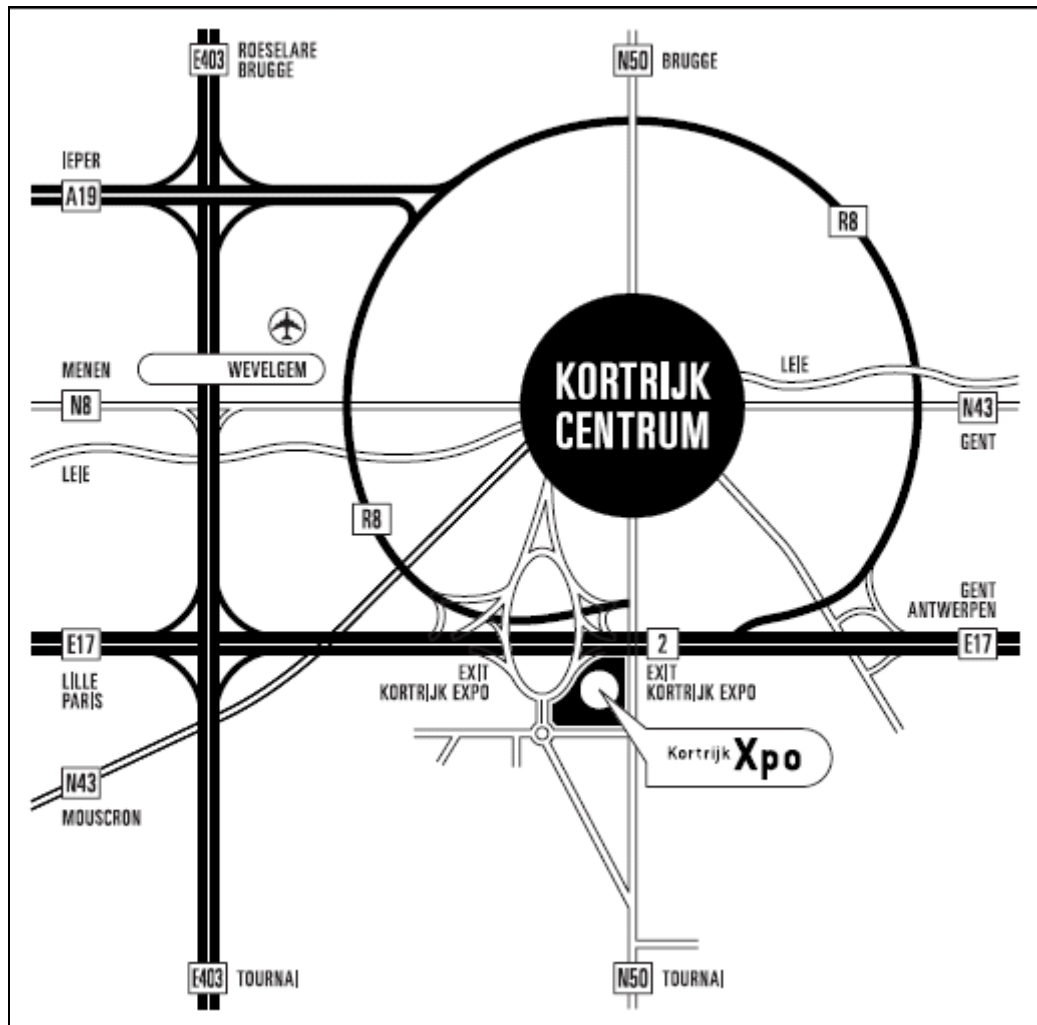
### By train & bus:

There are good railway connections from all Belgian towns to Kortrijk.

- From the Netherlands:  
Travel via Roosendaal to Antwerp or Brussels, where you take the train to Kortrijk.
- From Germany:  
Take a train to Aken - Leuven - Brussels - Ghent - Kortrijk.
- From France:  
Take the Eurostar to Lille and then a direct train to Kortrijk / Courtrai.
- From the U.K.:  
Take the Eurostar from London to Lille and then a direct train to Kortrijk.

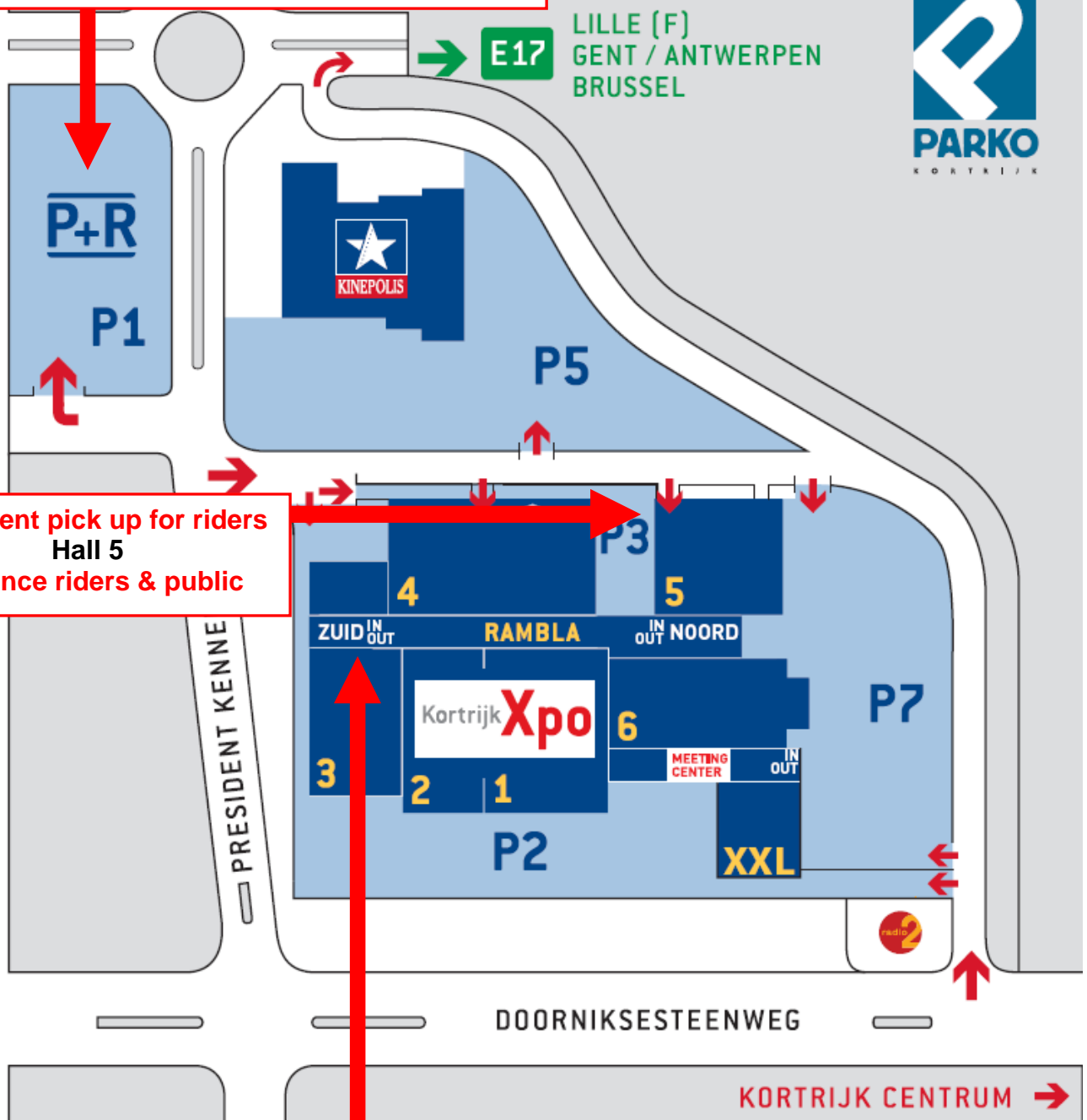

### 13) Map of the groundsite

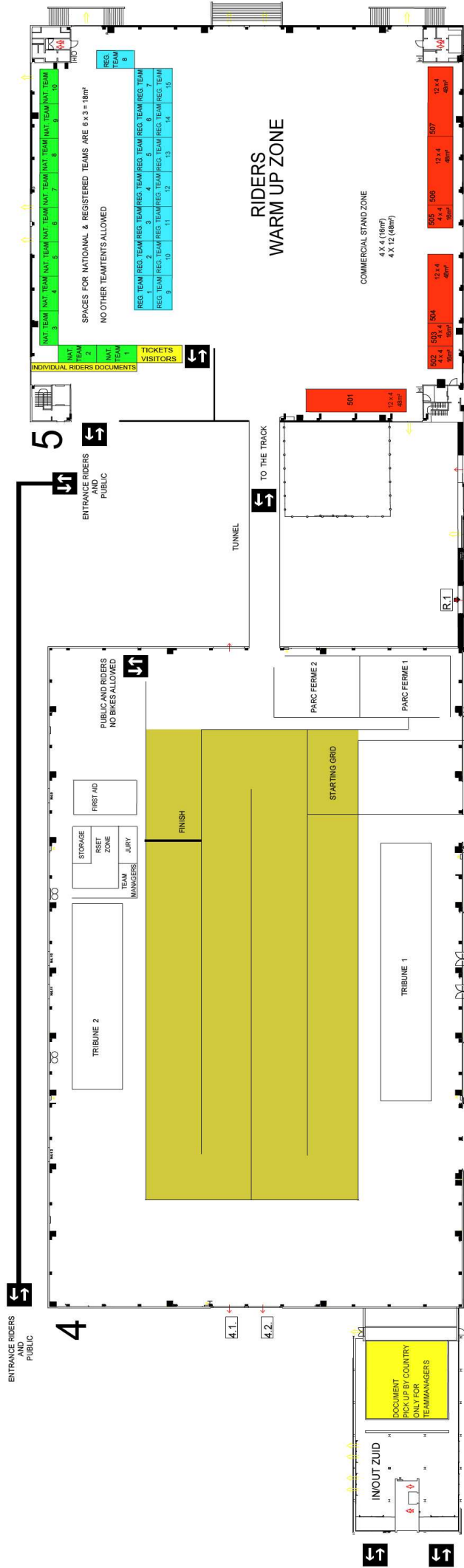
